CALL FOR WRITTEN SUBMISSIONS FROM STAKEHOLDER BODIES AND MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ON NATIONAL POLICY FOR THE PROVISIONING AND MANAGEMENT OF LEARNING AND TEACHING SUPPORT MATERIAL FOR GRADES R-12

I, Angelina Matsie Motshekga, Minister of Basic Education, hereby, in terms of *section 3(4)(o) of the National Education Policy Act, 1996 (Act No. 27 of 1996)*, and after consultation with the Council of Education Ministers, give my intention to approve national policy for the provisioning and management of learning and teaching support material. In view of this, I invite stakeholder bodies and members of the public to comment on the relevant policy changes as set out in the paragraph 2 below.
